Course Description

Reading: Can read menu and simple forms. Can read some shop signs and MRT station names.

Writing: Can write simple words and sentences.

Class Requirements & Grading

- a. Attendance (30%)
- b. Classroom performance (20%)
- c. Quizzes and Oral Tests (20%)
- d. Skit and Presentation (30%)
- P.S.1. There are total 18 classes (weeks) of the Elementary Chinese class, you are required to attend more than 15 classes (weeks) in order to pass the class for this semester. If you did not attend more than 15 classes (weeks), you will be Failed and you are required to re-take this class again next year. On-time attendance is required for all students. Any early leave or late arrival over 20 minutes will be considered as absence.
 - 2. **Any reason for absences will not be accepted.** If you are planning to go back to your country more than 3 weeks during this semester, you are required to re-take the Elementary Chinese class again next year.
 - 3. If you miss 1 class (week), you will lose 5 points from your final grade; if you miss 2 classes (weeks), you will lose 10 points from your final grade; if you miss 3 classes (weeks), you will lose 20 points from your final grade; if you miss more than 4 classes (weeks), you will lose 40 points and you will need to **re-take** the Chinese class again next year.
- 4. To pass the Elementary Chinese class, you will need to **get at least 70** on your final grade. If you did not get 70 on your final grade, you will need to re-take the same Chinese class again next year.
- 5. After you registered for your class, you are not allowed to change/switch to another class during the semester. The teachers and the course schedule are totally different! If students change/switch their classes, they will be recorded absence.
