In recent years, the global space industry attracts much attention. In view of rocket recovery, the rise of cube satellites, the low-earth-orbit communication satellites, short-term space travel and many others, the prospects of the space industry are unlimited.

Taiwan Space Agency is a dedicated research institution for the promotion of space development in Taiwan. It has been transformed into an Incorporated Administrative Agency since January 2023. The English title has been changed from NSPO (National Space Organization) to TASA (Taiwan Space Agency). And the resources are increased accordingly to have a national space program which aims to fulfill the goal of complete space technology development of Taiwan.
